

What to do before entering the tunnel



Check you have **sufficient fuel**



Tune into FM **radio** station to hear safety instructions, in case of incident



Switch on **headlights**, take off your sunglasses



Obey lane **control signs**



Observe **height** restriction

What to do inside the tunnel



Maintain a safe distance between vehicles



Stay in lane, do not overtake



Do not turn or reverse, Do not stop, except in an emergency, until you have left the tunnel and are clear of the exit

What to do in the event of breakdown or accident



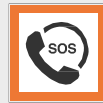
Switch on your warning **lights**



Switch off the engine



Stay close to your vehicle



Call for help from a safety panel

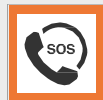
What to do if your or another vehicle is on fire



If your vehicle is on fire, if possible **drive out of the tunnel**



If that is not possible, pull over to the side, switch off your engine and **leave the vehicle immediately, use the nearest emergency exit**



Call for help from a safety panel



If you can, **put out the fire** using **fire fighting appliances** (extinguisher or hose reel) available at the safety panels in the tunnel
